It is believed that during the transit, **Tula, Vrishika, and Dhanu raasi** devotees should perform Shanti Pooja with Homam and Abhishekam to remove the evil effects and get blessings of Shani Bhagavan. Our learned priests also mentioned that Shani's effect will also be on **Kumbha raasi** devotees (Artha Ashtama Shani: 4th place) and on **Mithuna raasi** devotees (Ashtama Shani: 8th place).
